 constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of
 Greenville, on the southern end of Halloway Circle, being shown and designated as Lots
 Nos. 30 and 31 on a Plat entitled "Revision of Grandview Hills" made by R. B. Bruce,
 Surveyor, dated March 26, 1969, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County,
 South Carolina in Plat Book WW, Page 52, and having according to said Plat, the

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southern end of Halloway Circle on a cul-de-sac
 at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 31 and 42 (Lot No 42 has heretofore been sold
 according to description in Plat Book XX, Page 173); thence with the common line of
 said Lot, S. 1-0 W., 170 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 76-33 W., 103 feet to an iron
 pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos 31 and 25; thence with joint line of said
 Lots, N 32-24 W., 151.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 31
 and 30 and 25; thence with the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 30, N. 32-24 W.,
 110 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 25, 29 and 30; thence
 N 49-51 E., 160 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Halloway Circle; thence
 along said Circle, S. 45-18 E., 105.5 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along
 said Circle S. 5-09 E., 18 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots Nos.
 30 and 31; thence along the cul-de-sac of said Circle, the chord of which is S.
 51-03 E., 60 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
