

14. That in the event this mortgage shall be foreclosed, the Mortgagee shall be entitled to the proceeds of the sale of the premises in accordance with the provisions of the 1961 Code of Laws of South Carolina as amended, or in the absence of such laws...

THE MORTGAGE COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS

1. That should the Mortgagee prepay a portion of the indebtedness secured by this mortgage, or should the mortgagor prepay a portion of the indebtedness secured by this mortgage, the Mortgagee shall be entitled to the proceeds of the sale of the premises in accordance with the provisions of the 1961 Code of Laws of South Carolina as amended, or in the absence of such laws...

2. That the Mortgagee shall hold and enjoy the above described premises until the principal and interest thereon shall be paid in full, and it is the intention of the parties hereto that in the event of the foreclosure of this mortgage, the proceeds of the sale of the premises shall be applied to the payment of the principal and interest thereon, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the mortgagor or his heirs, assigns and assigns.

It is mutually agreed that if there is a default in any of the terms and conditions of this mortgage, the Mortgagee shall be entitled to the proceeds of the sale of the premises in accordance with the provisions of the 1961 Code of Laws of South Carolina as amended, or in the absence of such laws...

It is further agreed that the covenants herein contained shall bind and the benefits and advantages shall inure to the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, grantees and assigns of the parties hereto. Wherever used the singular shall include the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
