TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

TERRY M. HORNE and DEBRA T. HORNE
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto LAURENS FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, LAURENS, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of-----TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 ----- DOLLARS (\$ 22,500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate provided for in said note, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, except that the final payment of principal and interest shall be due on

November 1, 2000, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, containing 2.0 acres, located on the Northern side of Thomason View Road, as shown on plat entitled "Property of Terry M. and Debra T. Horne", dated May 24, 1975, prepared by T. H. Walker, Jr., and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an old iron pin in the middle of Thomason View Road, and running thence with the line of property, now or formerly, of Sullivan, N. 10-45 W., 220.5 feet to an old iron pin; thence S. 76-30 W., 55 feet to an old iron pin; thence N. 10-58 W., 134.3 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly, of James H. Thomason Estate; thence with said line N. 76-30 E., 280.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10-45 E. 354.8 feet to a nail and cap in the center of Thomason View Road, passing over iron pin 27 feet back on line; thence S. 76-30 W., 225.0 feet to the point of beginning. Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagors herein by deed recorded in Deed Volume 1021 at page 469 in the RMC Office for Greenville County.



Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

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
