WHEREAS: Gene Melvin McHargue and Laura B. McHargue

Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, is indebted to

called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incor-  
porated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Seventeen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty and  
No/100ths-----Dollars (\$17, 950. 00---), with interest from date at the rate of  
nine-----per centum ( 9. 00%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable  
at the office of Cameron-Brown Company  
in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may  
designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of One Hundred Forty  
Four and 50/100ths-----Dollars (\$144. 50-----), commencing on the first day of  
November, 1975, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and  
interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and  
payable on the first day of October, 2005.

payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor  
in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does  
grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described  
property situated in the county of Greenville  
State of South Carolina; and being more particularly described as Lot 74, as shown on a  
plat entitled "Section Two, Subdivision for Burlington Industries, Inc., Taylors,  
South Carolina," made by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, July 8, 1965, and  
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book  
JJJ, at page 49. According to said plat, the within described lot is also known as  
No. 7 Hill Street and fronts thereon 69.4 feet.
