TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: we, Nicholas G. Mavroftas and Donna F. Mavroftas

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of Twenty Two Thousand and NO/100 DOLLARS

(\$ 22,000.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is -Twenty- years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

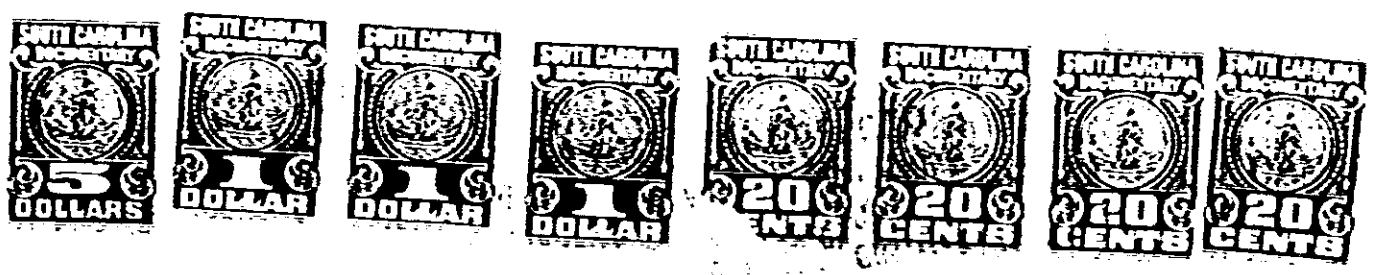
NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, situated on the south side of Woburn Way, about one and one-half miles northwestward from the City of Greer, Oneal Township, and being LOT NO. 26 of "WOBURN COURT" property of W. Dennis Smith, according to survey and plat by John A. Simmons, R.S., dated December 11, 1963, and recorded in Plat Book HHH at page 19, RMC Office, and having according to said plat, the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Woburn Way, corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 26 and running thence along the line of said Lots S. 4-43 W. 177.9 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot No. 22; thence along the line of Lots Nos. 22 and 21, N. 87-02 W. 105 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 27; thence along line of Lot No. 27, N. 4-43 E. 177.9 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Woburn Way; thence along the said Way, S. 87-02 E. 105 feet to the beginning corner.

This is that same property conveyed to Mortgagors by deed of Joseph C. Cordle, to be recorded in RMC Office for said County and State.

This property is subject to restrictive covenants and all easements and rights of way of record.



Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
