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PARCEL NO. 12

JOCASSEE HYDROELECTRIC PLANT

The hydroelectric generating plant of the Company known as its Jocassee Hydroelectric Plant located on Keowee River in Pickens County, South Carolina, which plant with an installed nameplate capacity of 305,000 kw (two (2) units of 152,500 kw each) was completed and put in operation in 1974 with necessary switching stations and step-up transformers. Two additional units of 152,500 kw nameplate capacity each, put in operation in May, 1975, bring the installed nameplate capacity to 610,000 kw with necessary switching stations and step-up transformers.

PARCEL NO. 13

BELEWS CREEK STEAM PLANT

The steam electric generating plant of the Company known as its Belews Creek Steam Plant located on Belews Creek in Stokes County, North Carolina, which plant with an installed initial nameplate capacity of 1,080,000 kw was put in operation in 1974 with necessary switching station and step-up transformers. An additional unit of 1,080,000 kw nameplate capacity began production in 1975.
