TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: INEZ E. GALLOWAY

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of Sixteen Thousand and Five Hundred ----- DOLLARS

(\$ 16,500.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is 15 years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as portions of Lots 1 and 2, Section B of the property of Alice M. and H. H. Willis as shown upon plat prepared by W. J. Riddle recorded in the Greenville County R.M.C. Office in Plat Book J at pages 150 and 151 and being more specifically described by a plat dated November 2, 1965 by C. O. Riddle entitled "Property of E. J. Wilson". Said plat recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book LLL at page 88, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Clemson Avenue being joint corner of property of the Grantor and Grantee; thence along the Northwestern side of Clemson Avenue N. 48-40 E. 90 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-26 W. 139.4 feet to an iron pin in the line of the Greenville County School District property; thence along the line of that property S. 63-55 W. 188 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 74-22 E. 221.6 feet to the beginning corner.

ALSO, ALL that certain lot, tract or parcel of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 3, Section B of the property of H. H. Willis and Alice M. Willis made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, November, 1939 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book J, at pages 150 and 151 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Clemson Avenue, being the joint front corner of Lot Nos. 4 and 3, and continuing along said lot line N. 41-20 W. 211.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 64-15 E. 98 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 74-22 E. 221.6 feet to an iron pin on Clemson Avenue; thence along Clemson Avenue S. 48-40 W. 215 feet to the beginning corner.
