## PROPOSED COMPRESSOR STATION No. 0105 -- HOUSING SITE

That certain tract of land conveyed to the Company by deed from Woodrow Heath, *et ux*, dated May 20, 1957, recorded in Book 37, page 401, of the Deed Records of Coosa County, Alabama, conveying the following described property situated in Coosa County, Alabama, to wit: Beginning at a point 200 feet in an easterly direction along the center line of Alabama Highway No. 22 from the southeast corner of that certain tract of land conveyed by John A.
