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State of South Carolina; on the eastern side of Millcrest Way, being shown and designated as Lot 65 on a Plat of ADAMS MILL ESTATES, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4-R, at Page 31, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds:
