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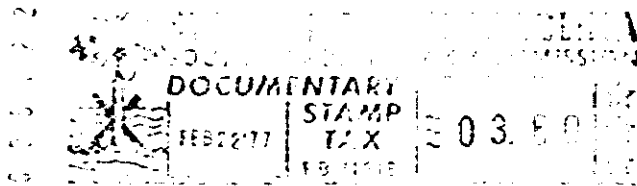

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All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 19 on plat of Crescent Terrace, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E at Page 137 and having, according to said plat, and a more recent plat entitled "Property of Mary Frances McMurria and James Austin McMurria" by Dalton & Neves, Eng. dated August 17, 1959, the following courses and distances, to-wit:
