To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

DONALD M. KRYSTON AND JEANNE M. KRYSTON

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of Twenty Seven Thou-

sand Fifty and No/100----- (\$27,050.00 ...)

Dollars as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note does not provide a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain

conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of

Seventeen and 66/100----- (\$217.66) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner years after date: and paid, to be due and payable 30

WHEREAS said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortzagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Pollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the West side of Second Day Street and being known and designated as Lot No. 78 as shown on plat entitled "Canterbury Subdivision, Section II" prepared by Heaner Engineering Co., dated July 17, 1972, and subsequently revised through March 31, 1976, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, State of South Carolina in Plat Book 5P, Page 31 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Second Day Street, at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 78 and 79 and runs thence with the line of Lot 79 N. 43-15-34 W., 128.58 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 77 S. 61-28-20 E., 114.41 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Second Day; thence with the curb of Second Day Street (the chord of which is S. 34-00-28 W., 108.31 feet) to the beginning corner.
