Payments Due on Sundays and Holidays. SECTION 1406 In any case where the date of maturity of interest or premium, if any, on or principal of the Bonds or the date fixed for redemption of any Bonds shall be a Sunday or shall be in South Carolina or in the jurisdiction where the principal corporate trust office of the Trustee is located, a legal holiday or a day on which banking institutions are authorized by law to close, then payment of interest or principal (and premium, if any) need not be made on such date in such city but may be made on the next succeeding business day not a Sunday or a legal holiday or a day upon which banking institutions are authorized by law to close with the same force and effect as if made on the date of maturity or the date fixed for redemption and no interest shall accrue for the period after such date.

SECTION 1407 Counterparts. This Indenture may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original and all of which shall constitute but one and the same instrument.

Laws Governing Indenture and Situs and SECTION 1408 Administration of Trust. The effect and meaning of this Indenture and the rights of all parties hereunder shall be governed by, and construed according to, the laws of the State of South Carolina, but it is the intention of the County that the situs of the trust created by this Indenture to be in the state in which is located the corporate trust office of the Trustee from time to time acting under this Indenture. The word "Trustee" as used in the preceding sentence shall not be deemed to include any additional individual or institution appointed as a separate or cotrustee pursuant to Section 1113 of this Indenture. It is the further intention of the County that the Trustee administer said trust in the state in which is located, from time to time, the situs of said trust.
