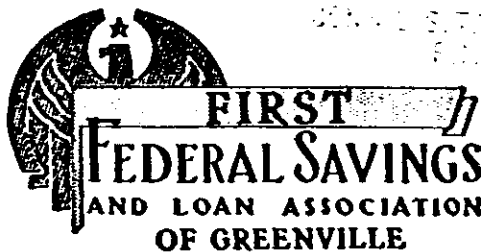

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

IVA S. KENSINGER

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$ 16,500.00)

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note does not contain a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain

conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of One Hundred

Thirty-two and 87/100 (\$ 132.87) Dollars each on the first day of each

month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 25 years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot No. 44 and the eastern portion of Lot No. 45 of a subdivision known as Lanneau Drive Highlands, as shown on plat thereof prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated August 1937, recorded in Plat Book D at Page 305 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of East Faris Road at the joint front corner of Lots 36 and 44 and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N 26-13 W 140 feet to a 10-ft. alley; thence along the line of said alley, S 63-47 W 70 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of lot conveyed by E.E. Mitchell to W.H. Childers; thence along the line of that lot, S 26-13 E 140 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of East Faris Road; thence along the northern side of said Road, N 63-47 E 70 feet to the beginning corner. Excepted from this conveyance is a strip of land 0.8 feet wide which was conveyed by E.E. Mitchell to the City of Greenville on September 12, 1950, recorded in Deed Book 440 at Page 404 for the purpose of widening East Farris Road.

This is the same property conveyed to the Mortgagor by deed of John Henry Davis, Sr. and Emmie Sue Davis recorded even date herewith.
