TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtentness to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all built-in stoves and refrigerators, heating, air conditioning, plumbing and electrical fixtures will to wall carpeting, fences and gates, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached connected or fitted in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, be considered a part of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described premises in tee simple absolute, that the above described premises are free and clear of all lens or other encumbrances, that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or encumber the same; and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

THE MORIGAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

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- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of Lws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes: and all sums so advanced shall lear interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be created, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgage, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgagee and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgagee should it so require and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgage; and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate notice thereof to the Mortgagee by registered mail, and should the Mortgagor at any time full to keep said premises insured or full to pay the premisms for such insurance, then the Mortgagee may consessed improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagor and reimburse itself for the cost of such mismance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so, the Mortgagor may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and change the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as hereimbeve provided.
- 5. That the Mortzagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtedness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.

That Mortgagor agrees to pay all tales and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged promises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgager immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall full due, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this morteage secures a "construction bain", the Morteager agrees that the principal amount of the includences hereby secured shall be disbursed to the Morteagor in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this morteage and incorporated berein by reference.
- S. That the Mortzagor will not further encounter the premises alone described, without the prior consent of the Mortgago, and should the Mortgagor so encounter such premises, the Mortgagor may at its option, declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 9. That should the Mortzazor alternate the mortzazed premises by Contract of Sale, Bond for Talle, or Deed of Conveyance, and the within mortgage indebtedness is not paid in full, the Mortgazor or his Furchaser shall be required to file with the Association an application for an assumption of the mortgage indebtedness, pay the reasonal le cost as required by the Association for processing the assumption, furnish the Association with a copy of the Contract of Sale, Bond for Talle or Deed of Conveyance, and have the interest rate on the loan balance existing at the time of transfer modified by increasing the interest rate on the said ban balance to the maximum rate per annun permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina Liu, or a lesser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. That the Mortgazor hereby assigns to the Mortzagee, its successors and assigns all the rents issues and profits according from the mortzaged premises, retaining the right to cellect the some so for a as the debt hereby second is not in amount of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtohiess, or interest, taxes, or fine mornage profitions, he past the and mopaid, the Mortzagee may without notice or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they shall be occupied by a tenant or tenants, and collect said rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtehness hardly second, without hability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of cellection, and any tenant is authorized upon request by Mortzagee, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgagee without liability to the Mortgager until ratified to the contrary by the Mortgagee; and should said premises at the time of such default be occupied by the Mortgager, the Mortgagee may apply to the Judge of the County Court or to any Judge of the Court of Common Pleas who shall be resolved an order of the county aforesaid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect such rents and profits, applying said rents, after paying the cost of collection, to the mortgage debt without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.
