

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Creenville, being shown and designated as Lot No. 4 on plat of property of Nell T. BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northeastern corner of property now or formerly belonging to Nell T. Ward at a point 370 feet east of New Buncombe Road and running thence N. 83-28 E. 167.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-00 E. 215 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 75-07 W. 26.1 feet to an iron pin at the joint corners of Lots No. 3 and 4; thence with the line of Lot No. 3 N. 6-32 W. 145.5 feet to a point at the rear of a 19 foot street sometimes referred to as Forest Drive; thence across the end of said street N. 6-32 W. 20 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
