WHEREAS, we the said Virgil D. Wactor and Dorothy A. Wactor

Eleven Thousand & No/100 ----- (\$ 11,000.00) Dollars,
with interest from the date hereof at the rate of Eight 1/2 per cent (8-1/2 %) per annum, unpaid interest to
