TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: WILLIAM C. DEWITT AND SHIRLEY J. DEWITT

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of

Twenty Thousand Eight Hundred and 00/100----- DOLLARS

(\$ 20,800.00-----), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is 25 years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 80 on the eastern side of Vinson Drive, as shown on a plat of a Subdivision known as Longforest Acres, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book JJJ at Page 79, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Vinson Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 79 and 80 and running thence with the line of Lot 79, N. 77-13 E. 160 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot 78; thence with the line of Lot 78, N. 12-47 W. 80 feet to a point; thence with the line of Lot 82, N. 28-50 W. 21.4 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 80 and 81; thence with the line of Lot 81, S. 77-13 W. 154.5 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Vinson Drive; thence along Vinson Drive, N. 12-47 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

BEING the same property conveyed to the Mortgagors herein by deed of Charles B. Barrett, said deed being dated of even date.
