conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of ______ Two Hundred______

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mostgagor may bereafter become indebted to the Mostgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mostgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL, MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, lurgained, sold, and released, and to these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, bying and bring in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 99 of a subdivision known as Coach Hills according to a plat thereof recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4-X at Page 94, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Red Pox Court at the joint front corner of Lots 99 and 100, and running thence with the joint Cline of said lots, S. 53-07 E. 168.20 feet to an iron pin at the joint Trear corner of Lots Nos. 99 and 100; thence with the rear of Lot No. 99, S. 67-57 W. 240 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lot Nos. 98 and 99; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 15-19 E. 168.40 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Red Pox Court; thence with the southern side of Red Pox Court; thence with the southern side of Red Pox Court, the chord of which is N. 56-40 E. 752.27 feet to the point of beginning.
