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TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, bereditanients, and apportenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all built-in stores and refrigerators, beating, an conditioning, phinding and electrical fixtures wall to wall carpeting, fences and gates, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached to unrefed in the day number, it being the intention of the parties bereto that all such fixtures and expiriment, other than boosehold furniture, be considered a part of the reality.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seried of the above described premises in fee simple absolute, that the above described premises are free and clear of all bens or other encombrances, that the Mortgagor is lawfolly empowered to convey or encomber the same, and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfolly claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

## THE MORTGAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

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- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any koins or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgager under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes, and all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be erected, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgager, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgager and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgagere should it so require and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgager, and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate notice thereof to the Mortgager by registered mail, and should the Mortgagor at any time fail to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premiums for such insurance, then the Mortgagor may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagor and reinforuse itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so the Mortgagor may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as bereinabove provided.
- 5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indeletelness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage delet, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage delet.
- 6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgagor immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgagor may, at its option, pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage deld and collect the same under this mortgago, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this meeting secures a "construction loan", the Meetinger agrees that the principal amount of the indefeedness berely secured shall be discussed to the Meetinger in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but as made a part of this meetinge and incorporated berein by reference.
- S. That the Meetgages will not further encumber the premises alone described, without the pend consent of the Meetgages, and should the Meetgages so encumber such premises the Meetgages may at its egition, declare the indebtedness barely secured to be annuclaisely due and payable and may notative any proceedings necessary to collect and indebtedness.
- 9. That should the Mostgagos alienate the mostgaged premises by Contract of Sale, Bond for Tale, on Deed of Conveyance, and the within mostgage indefeedness is not paid in full, the Mostgagos on his Furchases shall be required to file with the Association an assumption of the mostgage indefeedness, pay the reasonable cost as required by the Association for processing the assumption furnish the Association with a copy of the Contract of Sale, Bond for Tale on Deed of Conveyance, and have the interest rate on the loan balance existing at the time of transfer modified by increasing the interest rate on the said loan balance to the maximum rate per annum permutted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a losser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. The Association will notify the Mostgagos or his purchoses of the new interest rate and monthly payments and will read him a new possbook. Should the Mostgagos, or his Furchases, had to comply with the provisions of the within paragraph the Mostgagos, at its option, may declare the indefeedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indefeedness.
- 10. That should the Mortgagor full to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory note and the same shall be argued for a period of thirty (30) days or if there should be any failine to occuply with and alode by my by-laws or the charter of the Mortgagor, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the Mortgagor at its equion may write to the Mortgagor at his last known address giving him thirty (30) days in which to rectify the said default and should the Mortgagor full to rectify said default within the said thirty days the Mortgagor, may at its equion, increase the interest rate on the loan believe for the remaining term of the loan or for a lesser term to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase rate as may be determined by the Association. The monthly payments will be adusted accordingly.
- 11. That should the Mortgagor fail to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory ande and should any mentaly installment become past due for a period in excess of 15 days, the Mortgagor may collect a "late charge" not to exceed an amount equal to five (5%) per certum of any such past due installment in order to converte extra expense incident to the handling of such delinquent payments.
- 12. That the Mortgagor herely assigns to the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, all the rents issues, and profits accruing from the mortgagod premises, retaining the right to collect the same so long as the deld herely second is not in arrears of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, taxes, or fire insurance premions, he past due and unquid, the Mortgagoe may without rotice or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they shall be occupied by a tenant or tenants, and collect said rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of collection and any tenant is authorized, upon request by Mortgagoe, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgagoe, without liability to the Mortgagoe until notified to the contrary by the Mortgagoe; and should said premises at the time of such default be occupied by the Mortgagoe, the Mortgagoe may apply to the Judge of the Country Court or to any Judge of the Court of Common Pleas who shall be resident or presiding in the country for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect such rents and profits, applying said rents, after paying the cost of collection, to the mortgage delit without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.
- 13. That the Mortgagee, at its option, may require the Mortgagor to pay to the Mortgage, on the first day of each month until the note secured hereby is fully paid, the following sums in addition to the payments of principal and interest provided in said note: a sum equal to the premiums that will nest become due and payable on policies of mortgage guaranty insurance (if applicable), fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property; plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged premises (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) less all sums already paid therefor, divided by the number of months to clapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums taxes, and assessments will be due and payable, such sums to be held by Mortgagee on said premiums, taxes and special assessments. Should these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgage for taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums, the excess may be credited by the Mortgagee on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgager, it, however, said sums shall be insufficient to make said payments when the same shall become due and payable, the Mortgager shall pay to the Mortgagee any amounts necessary to make up the deficiency. The Mortgagor further agrees that at the end of ten years from the date bereof, Mortgagee may, at its option apply for renewal of mortgage guaranty or similar insurance (if applicable) covering the balance then remaining due on the mortgage debt, and the Mortgagor may, at its option, pay the single premium required for the remaining years of the term or the Mortgagee may pay such premium and add the same to the nontgage debt in which event the Mortgagor shall repay to Mortgagee such premium payment, with interest, at the rate specified in said promissory note, in equal monthly installments over the remaining payment period.

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
