"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or bereafter constructed thereon, situate, bying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot No. 25 on Plat Entitled Section 1, Powderhorn, dated July 26, 1973, most recently revised March 1, 1974, prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4X, at Page 95 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the western side of Rainwood Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 25 and 26 and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 85-25 W. 150 feet; thence S. 4-06 W. 100 feet; thence N. 83-05 E. 46.10 feet to a point; thence N. 86-01 E. 106 feet to a point on Rainwater Drive; thence with said street N. 3-59 E. 75.0 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 25 and 26 to the point and place of beginning.
