(19) To maintain improvements and repair and make repairs required by the Government, operate the property in a sound and husband-like manner, comply with such farm conservation practices and farm and home management plans as the Government from time to time may prescribe, and not to stand on the property, or cause or permit waste, lessening or impairment of the security covered hereby, or without the written consent of the Government, cut, remove, or lease any timber, mineral, oil, gas, coal, or other minerals except as may be necessary for ordinary domestic purposes.

(20) To comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations affecting the property.

(21) To pay or reimburse the Government for expenses reasonably necessary or incidental to the protection of the land and property herein and to the extent of the non-compliance with the provisions hereof and of the supplemental agreement whether before or after default, including but not limited to costs of evidence of title to any interest of the property, costs of recording the deed, other instruments, attorneys' fees, trustees' fees, court costs, and expenses of advertising, selling, and certifying the property.

(22) Neither the property nor any portion thereof or interest therein shall be leased, assigned, sold, transferred, or encumbered, voluntarily or otherwise, without the written consent of the Government. The Government shall have the sole and exclusive rights as mortgagor hereunder, including but not limited to the power to grant waivers, partial releases, subordinations, and satisfaction, and no insured holder shall have any right, title or interest in or to the land or any benefit hereof.

(23) At all reasonable times the Government and its agents may inspect the property to ascertain whether the covenants and agreements contained herein or in any supplemental agreement are being performed.

(24) The Government may extend and defer the maturity of and renew and reschedule the debt evidenced by the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, release from liability to the Government any party so liable thereon, release portions of the property from and subordinate the land hereof, and waive any other rights hereunder, without affecting the burden or liability of the Government or Borrower or any other party for payment of the note or indebtedness secured hereby except as specified by the Government in writing.

(25) If at any time it shall appear to the Government that Borrower may be able to obtain a loan from a products credit association, a Federal land bank, or other responsible cooperative or private credit source, at reasonable rates and terms for loans for similar purposes and periods of time, Borrower will upon the Government's request, apply for and accept such loan in sufficient amount to pay the note and any indebtedness secured hereby and to pay the any stock necessary to be purchased in a cooperative lending agency in connection with such loan.

(26) Default hereunder shall constitute default under any other real estate, or under any personal property, other security instrument held or issued by the Government and executed or assumed by Borrower, and default under any such other security instrument shall constitute default hereunder.

(27) SHOULD DEFAULT occur in the performance or discharge of any obligation in this instrument or secured by this instrument, or should any one of the parties named as Borrower die or be declared incompetent, a bankrupt, or an insolvent, or make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, the Government at its option, with or without notice, may: (a) declare the entire amount unpaid under the note and any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured immediately due and payable, (b) sue for the account of Borrower and pay reasonable expenses for repairing, maintaining, and taking possession of, separate or from the property, (c) upon application by it and production of this instrument, without notice of hearing, if said application has a receiver appointed for the property, with the usual powers of receivers in like cases, (d) foreclose this instrument as provided herein or by law, and repossess any and all other rights and remedies provided herein or by present or future law.

(28) The proceeds of forced sale sale shall be applied in the following order to the payment of taxes and expenses incident to collecting or complying with the provisions herein, (a) any proceedings required by law of a competent court to be paid, (b) the debt evidenced by the note and all indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, (c) infinite heirs of record required by law of a competent court to be so paid, (d) at the Government's option, any other indebtedness of Borrower which is incurred by the Government, and (e) any balance to be so paid. At foreclosure or other sale of all or any part of the property, the Government and its agents shall be a stranger and may pay the Government's share of the purchase price by crediting such amount on any debt of Borrower owing to or incurred by the Government in the order prescribed above.

(29) Borrower agrees that the Government will not be bound by any present or future State law, (a) providing for valuation, appraisal, homestead or exemption of the property, (b) prohibiting maintenance of an action for a deficiency judgment or limiting the amount thereof or the time within which such action may be brought, (c) prescribing any other statute of limitations, (d) allowing any rights of redemption or repossession following any forced sale or terminating the conditions of the Government may by regulation impose, including the interest rate it may charge, as a condition of appraising a transfer of the property to a new Borrower, Borrower expressly waives the benefit of any such State law. Borrower hereby relinquishes, waives, and conveys all and to, such use or non-use, of descent, power, and currency.

(30) If any part of the loan for which this instrument is given shall be used to finance the purchase, construction, or repair of property to be used as an owner-occupied dwelling (herein called "the dwelling") and if Borrower intends to sell or rent the dwelling and has obtained the Government's consent to do so, (a) neither Borrower nor anyone authorized to act for him, will, after receipt of a bona fide offer, refuse to negotiate for the sale or rental of the dwelling or will otherwise make unavailable to deny the dwelling to anyone because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin; and (b) Borrower recognizes as illegal and hereby disclaims and will not comply with or attempt to enforce any restrictive covenants on dwelling relating to race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

(31) This instrument shall be subject to the present regulations of the Farmers Home Administration, and to its future regulations not inconsistent with the express provisions hereof.

(32) Notices given hereunder shall be sent by certified mail, unless otherwise required by law, addressed, unless and until some other address is designated in a notice so given, in the case of the Government to Farmers Home Administration, United States Department of Agriculture, at Columbia, South Carolina, 29201, and in the case of Borrower to him at the address shown in the Farmers Home Administration Finance Office records which normally will be the same as the post office address shown above.

(33) If any provision of this instrument or application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity will not affect other provisions or applications of the instrument which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to that end the provisions hereof are declared to be severable.
