WHEREAS, the said Mortgagor(s) in and by dy certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these Presents, am well and truly indebted to BANK OF GREER, GREER, S. C., hereinafter called Mortgagee, in the full and just sum of

Twenty Two Thousand (\$22,000.00)----- DOLLARS
to be paid in monthly installments of \$1,833.15 commencing on the 1st day of February, 1978
and on the 1st day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not paid sooner, shall be due and payable on the 1st day of January 1992.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 9 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly, as stated above, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and in case said note should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection the Mortgagor(s) agrees to pay all costs and expenses including a reasonable amount as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor(s) paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Hick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located three miles northwest from Greer, S. C., lying on the north side of the road that leads from the Old Rutherford Road to the St. Marks Road, and being known as lot number 140 (2), on plan of lots made for H. C. Copeland by H. S. Brockman, surveyor, dated Nov. 21, 1906 and having the following notes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning on a stake in the said road, joint corner of lots 1 and 2, and runs thence with the dividing line of lots 1 and 2, N. 6° 28' W., 217 feet to iron pin; thence N. 34-1/2° W., 116.0 feet to pin on road, joint rear corner of lots 2 and 3; thence with lot No. 3, S. 6-45' W., 242 feet to road; thence N. 34-1/2° E., 120 feet along road and N. 34-1/2° E., 20 feet along road to the beginning corner.
