ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the  
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated  
as Lot No. 9 as shown on plat of Paramount Park prepared by Piedmont  
Engineering Service, dated July, 1949, and recorded in the RMC Office for  
Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book W, at Page 57, and having, according  
to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Lombard Lane and running  
thence with the western side of Lombard Lane N. 43-15 W. 85 feet to an iron  
pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence with the line of Lot  
No. 10 S. 46-45 W. 110 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots  
Nos. 8, 9, and 10; thence with the line of Lot No. 8 S. 43-15 E. 110 feet  
to an iron pin on the northern side of Crosby Circle; thence with the northern  
side of Crosby Lane the following courses and distances: N. 46-45 E. 85  
feet to an iron pin; N. 1-45 E. 35.4 feet to the point of BEGINNING.
