The following described property being real estate situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina.

ALL THAT piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northwestern side of Neal Circle, being known and designated as Lot No. 33, as shown on a Plat of Map of North Acres, made by Dalton & Neves, December, 1952, and recorded in the RYC Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book 33, at pages 12 and 13, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Neal Circle, at the joint front corner of Lots 33 and 34, and running thence along the common line of said Lots N. 10-50 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence running N. 72-10 E. 80 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 32 and 33; thence with the common line of said Lots S. 10-50 E. 100 feet to an iron pin on the northwestern side of Neal Circle; thence with the line of said Neal Circle S. 72-10 W. 80 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to such easements, rights-of-way and restrictions of record or as appear on the premises.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantor, herein by deed recorded in the R.Y.C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 721, at page 123.

The above mentioned Street is now known as North Acres Drive.
