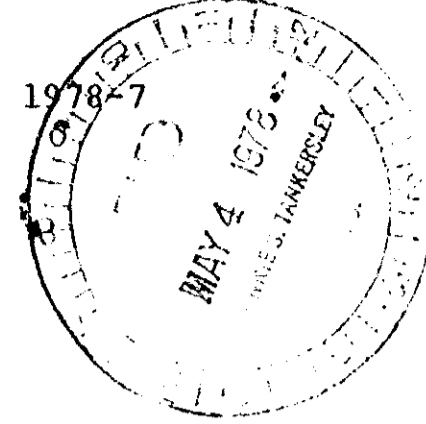

RELEASE

WHEREAS Duke Power Company did, on or about December 1, 1927, make, execute and deliver unto Guaranty Trust Company of New York, Trustee, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, its First and Refunding Mortgage dated on that day and duly recorded in the Public Registry of Greenville County, South Carolina, wherein and whereby Duke Power Company conveyed unto Guaranty Trust Company of New York, Trustee, certain property, both real and personal, to secure the payment of certain bonds as set out and referred to in said First and Refunding Mortgage; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the merger on April 24, 1959, of J. P. Morgan & Co., Incorporated with Guaranty Trust Company of New York, the corporate name of Guaranty Trust Company of New York was changed to Morgan Guaranty Trust Company of New York; and

WHEREAS Duke Power Company has sold or contracted and agreed to sell to T. C. HOOPER all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 0.36 acres, more or less, on the Western side of Burdine Road, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint corner of Duke Power Company property, and running thence S 42-27 W 205.3 feet to an iron pin; thence along the Hooper and Owens line N 38-44 W 105 feet to an iron pin; thence along the Burdine line N 57-52 E 205 feet to an iron pin; thence along Burdine Road S 37-54 E 50 feet to the BEGINNING.

Original mortgage is recorded in R.E.M. Book 201 at page 1.

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
