PARCEL NO. 2:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 14 and 15 of said subdivision, and running thence S. 25-16 E. 71 feet, more or less, to a point; thence N. 80-22 W. 123 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 13; thence with the rear lines of Lots Nos. 13 and 14 of said subdivision N. 64-44 E. 100 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
