That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (53.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, bying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southern side of Beaverdell Court, being shown and designated as Lot No. 65 on Plat of Bellingham, Section IV, prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, dated May 14, 1976, recorded in Plat Book 5-P, at Page 48, and being described, according to said plat, more particularly, to-wit:
