SAC-2-1

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 16.304 acres, more or less, shown on plat of property of Alvin D. Green prepared by C. O. Miller, Surveyor, April, 1966, revised July, 1966, recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book 133, page 133, and having according to said plat the following notes and boundaries:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of the Woodruff Road (S.C. Highway 146), which point is also the joint front corner of property of Burgeon and W. H. Jones, and running thence along the southwest side of the Woodruff Road, S. 42-17 E., 126.6 feet to an iron pin thereon continuing along the southwest side of said Woodruff Road, S. 42-17 E., 162.7 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the southwest side of the Woodruff Road, S. 43-34 E., 100 feet to an iron pin thereon continuing along the southwest side of the Woodruff Road, S. 43-34 E., 55.15 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of the Woodruff Road at the corner of a 60-foot street heretofore devised by A. D. Green to Greenville County; thence along said street, around a curve, the chord of which is S. 10-30 W., 22.7 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing S. 10-30 W. 40-foot street S. 66-00 N., 1724.8 (less 11.8) feet to an iron pin in line of property now or formerly of Edward J. Green; thence along the line of property of Edward J. Green, S. 66-00 N., 481.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 66-00 E., 1122 feet, a portion of which distance runs along the line of property of W. H. Jones, to an iron pin; thence continuing along the line of property of W. H. Jones, S. 00-44 E., 345.1 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the line of property of W. H. Jones N. 57-33 E., 65.6 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of the Woodruff Road, the beginning; corner.

The above described property is a portion of Tract No. 6 of a subdivision of the property of John L. Green and Anna L. Green. Tract No. 6 is shown on a plat recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book 8, page 133, and is a portion of the tract conveyed to Alvin D. Green by Clarence Green et al by deed dated December 1, 1944, recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book 169, page 67 and a small triangular tract of land set off to Alvin D. Green, by Coca Thompson Ballenger by deed dated August 1, 1946, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book 194, page 376.

SAC-2-17

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in the town of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the south side of Green River Road shown on a plat of Alvin D. Green prepared by Surveyor C. O. Miller, S. L. S., July, 1966, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the line of Edward J. Green property, S. 42-17 E., 100 feet west of an old iron pin at the joint front corner of Edward J. Green and Edward J. Green property, and running thence along said line S. 42-17 E., 100 feet to a point on Green River Road; thence S. 42-17 E., 111.1 feet to the point of beginning.

LEASE AND SUBLETTING

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, together with the brick building located thereon, situated lying and being on the North side of Green River Road 116 feet West of its intersection with S. 42-17 E., 100 feet from the intersection of the North side of Green River Road with the center line of Woodruff Road, in Greenville, South Carolina, as were fully delineated on the plat entitled "Oxford Industries, Inc.", near Greenville, S. C." dated October 13, 1970, by G.W. of Engineers and Architects, a copy of which is recorded in the R. M. C. office in Greenville County, in Plat Book 109, page 11.

Said property is more fully described according to said plat as follows:

Commenced at a railroad spike on the North side of Green River Road 116 feet West of the intersection with Woodruff Road (should be 100 feet from the intersection of the North side of Green River Road with the center line of Woodruff Road), being the POINT OF BEGINNING and running thence S. 42-17 E., 100 feet along Green River Road a distance of 100 feet to a point in the concrete continuing the North side of Green River Road a distance of 110.8 feet to an iron pipe continuing thence North S. 42-17 E., a distance of 613.7 feet to an iron pipe continuing thence North S. 42-17 E., a distance of 612.2 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING. To be all of the said dimensions a little more or less, and built and situated generally to the North on Green River Road and on all of the same on property of Oxford Industries, Inc.

Furnished with air conditioning, heating and sprinkler system installed in said brick building.

Land and Building, if any, are subject to two prior mortgages. The first mortgage is in favor of Oxford Industries, Inc., dated January 1, 1970, with an original principal sum of \$127,000.00, the second in favor of the South Carolina National Bank dated April 1, 1973 and is to the original principal sum of \$120,000.00.
