THIS MORTGAGE is made this 17 day of August 1978, between the Mortgagor, CHARLES DOUGLAS RICE, III AND NANCY H. RICE (herein "Borrower"), and the Mortgagee, POINSETT FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION of Travelers Rest, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, whose address is 203 State Park Road, Travelers Rest, S. C. 29690 (herein "Lender").

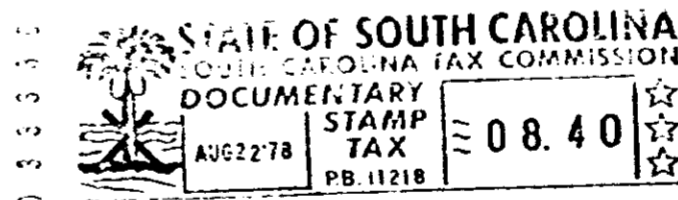
WHEREAS, Borrower is indebted to Lender in the principal sum of Twenty One Thousand and 00/100 (\$21,000.00) Dollars, which indebtedness is evidenced by Borrower's note dated August 17, 1978 (herein "Note"), providing for monthly installments of principal and interest, with the balance of the indebtedness, if not sooner paid, due and payable on August 1, 2003.

To SECURE to Lender (a) the repayment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon, the payment of all other sums, with interest thereon, advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements of Borrower herein contained, and (b) the repayment of any future advances, with interest thereon, made to Borrower by Lender pursuant to paragraph 21 hereof (herein "Future Advances"), Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender and Lender's successors and assigns the following described property located in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land located in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot 38 on a plat of Gaston Heights, said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book YY at Pages 49 and 101, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Paris View Drive at the rear corner of Lot 41 and running thence S. 08-11 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 81-49 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 08-11 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence along the Southern side of Paris View Drive, N. 81-49 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

BEING the same property conveyed to the Mortgagors herein by deed of G. P. Peterson, said deed being dated August 31, 1965 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 781 at Page 540.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD unto Lender and Lender's successors and assigns, forever, together with all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, rights, appurtenances, rents, royalties, mineral, oil and gas rights and profits, water, water rights, and water stock, and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to the property, all of which, including replacements and additions thereto, shall be deemed to be and remain a part of the property covered by this Mortgage; and all of the foregoing, together with said property (or the leasehold estate if this Mortgage is on a leasehold) are herein referred to as the "Property".

Borrower covenants that Borrower is lawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property, that the Property is unencumbered, and that Borrower will warrant and defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any declarations, easements or restrictions listed in a schedule of exceptions to coverage in any title insurance policy insuring Lender's interest in the Property.
