

Parcel No. 4: All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Saluda Township Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 100 acres, more or less, and being part of the same conveyed to Virginia B. Mann by Nancy G. Brown by deed recorded February 8, 1967, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 813, Page 447. Said property is bounded by lands now or formerly owned by Oscar Hodges, Amber, Bright, Neilson, McKoy and Parks, and by Old U. S. Hwy No. 25 and Terry Creek Road and lies in the northwest quadrant of the intersection of said roads.

Parcel No. 5: All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the northeastern side of Raines Avenue, containing 8 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of "B" Street and Raines Avenue, and running thence along "B" Street N. 46-1/2 E. 230 feet to an iron pin; thence still along "B" Street 1-1/2 E. 255 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 42 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 28 W. 700 feet to an iron pin on "A" Street; thence along "A" Street S. 42-1/2 W. 420 feet to an iron pin at the corner of "A" Street and Raines Avenue; thence along Raines Avenue S. 28 E. 700 feet to an iron pin; thence still along Raines Avenue S. 42 E. 360 feet to the beginning corner; Less, However, two lots heretofore conveyed by deeds recorded in Deed Book 219, Page 284 and Deed Book 243, Page 286. Said property is the same conveyed to James R. Mann by James B. Martin, et. al., by deed recorded on June 17, 1953 in Deed Book 480, Page 212, RMC Office for Greenville County.

Parcel No. 6: A one-sixth undivided interest in and to: All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 30 acres, more or less, and being situate on the western side of U. S. Highway No. 25 at its intersection with the Donaldson Spur Track of the Southern Railroad, and being bounded on the north by said Spur Track, on the south by a subdivision known as Pecan Terrace No. 2, on the east by U. S. Highway No. 25 and on the west by a subdivision known as Englewood Estates, and being the same devised to James R. Mann by A. C. Mann, deceased.
