Office for Spartanburg County, South Carolina, said beginning iron pin also being the southeastern corner of that certain tract of land conveyed by Milton E. Prevost and Jean W. Prevost to Jerry Bradshaw, by deed duly recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and running thence from said beginning iron pin and with the right of way of Southern Railway System four calls as follows: South 51 degrees 44 minutes East 190 feet to an iron pin, South 42 degrees 27 minutes East 146 feet to an iron pin, South 34 degrees 02 minutes East 150.8 feet to an iron pin, and South 26 degrees 48 minutes East 122 feet to an iron pin in the line of the property now or formerly belonging to C. B.
