

This mortgage, made this the 27th day of July , 19 79.

hereinafter cailed the Mortgagor (whether one or more persons), in the State aforesaid, Witnesseth: WHEREAS, the said Mortgagor is truly indebted unto AMERICAN CREDIT COMPANY OF SOUTH CARO- LINA, INC., a corporation, organized and existing under the Laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter
called the Mortgagee, in the sum of Nîne Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty and No/100
(§ 9,960.00) Dollars, as evidenced by promissory note of even date herewith, payable to the order of
Mortgagee in 60 consecutive monthly installments of \$ 166.00 each; the first installment being
due September 1, 1979, and the remaining installments are due on the same day of each month thereafter.

That the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debts and sums of money aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof and also to secure the payment of any other sums advanced to said Mortgagor under the terms and provisions of this Mortgage as hereinafter set forth, to the said Mortgagee according to the condition of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee, its successors or assigns,
the following described property situated in the County of <u>Greenville</u> . State of South Carolina:
ALL THAT PIECE, PARCEL OR LOT OF LAND in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the northern side of Highlawn Avenue, near the City of Greenville, being known as Lot No. 15 on plat of property of G. J. Douglass Estate made by C. M. Furman, Jr., April, 1923, recorded in Plat Book F, at Page 126, and according to a more recent survey prepared by C. C. Jones Engineer, May 29, 1951, is described as follows:
FIGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Highland Avenue (formerly Highlawn Avenue), which pin is 368.7-feet west of the intersection of said Avenue and Hill Street, and is the joint front corner of Lot Nos. 15 and 16, and running thence with the joint line of said lot No. 10-50 E. 141.3-feet to an iron pin; thence N. 79-10 W. 70-feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 14; thence with the line of said lot S. 10-50 W. 141.3-feet to an iron pin of the southern side of Highland Avenue; thence with said avenue S. 79-10 E. 70-feet in the point of beginning.
