WHEREAS, JAMES MCCRAY, JR. AND LORETTA D. MCCRAY, their heirs and assigns forever:

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto

HOUSEHOLD FINANCE CORPORATION

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the Amount Financed of

Six Thousand Five Hundred Eighteen and Twenty-Seven Cents Dollars (\$ 6,518.27) due and payable

with interest thereon from April 22, 1980 at the rate of 18.000 per centum per annum, to be paid:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the East side of Old Augusta Road, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as a part of Lot 3 on plat of McDaniel Tract, Property of Howard Caldwell, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book "E", at Page 218, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Old Augusta Road at joint corner of Lots 2 and 3 and running thence with the line of Lot 2, N. 60-45 E. 241.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 1-17 W. 55.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 60-45 W. 240.5 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Old Augusta Road; thence along the East side of Old Augusta Road, N. 1-45 W. 57.1 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to us by deed of Victor A. Tatum and Rebecca M. Tatum dated July 15, 1957, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Deed Book 580, at page 283.

This is the same property as conveyed to the Mortgagor herein by deed dated August 15, 1974 and recorded on August 15, 1974 in book 1005 page 36 of the Office of Recorder of Deeds of Greenville County, South Carolina.

Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

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
