TOGE HER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or, in any way incident or appertaining, including all built-in stoves and refrigerators, heating air conditioning, plumbing and electrical tixtures, wall to wall curpeting, fences and gates, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached connected or fitted in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furnation, be considered a part of the reality.

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TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described premises in the simple absolute; that the above described premises are free and clear of all liens or other encombrances; that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or encumber the same; and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsolver Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

## THE MORTGAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

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- 1. That the Mortgazor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor under the authority of Sec. 15-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, as an ended, or similar statutes; and all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be phyable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be erected, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgagee, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgagee and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgagee should it so require and shall include loss payable clauses in tayor of the Mortgagee; and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate notice thereof to the Mortgagee by registered mul, and should the Mortgagor at any time fall to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premiums for such insurance, then the Mortgagor may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagor and reimburse itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 5. That the Mortzigee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtedness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortzigee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgager agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgagee immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgager faul to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall full due, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this mortgage secures a "construction loan", the Mortgagor agrees that the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured shall be disbursed to the Mortgagor in periodic phyments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference.
- S. That the Mortgagor will not further encumber the premises above described, without the prior consent of the Mortgagor, and should the Mortgagor so encumber such premises, the Mortgagor may, at its option, declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 9. That should the Moitgagor alienate the moitgged premises by Contract of Sile, Bond for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and the within mortgage indebtedness is not paid in full, the Moitgger or his Purchaser shall be required to file with the Association an application for an assumption of the moitgage indebtedness, pay the reasonable cost as required by the Association for processing the assumption furnish the Association with a copy of the Contract of Sale. Bond for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and have the interest rate on the loan balance existing at the time of transfer modified by increasing the interest rate on the said loan balance to the maximum rate per armum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. The Association will notify the Mortgagor or his purchaser of the new interest rate and monthly payments, and will much him a new passbook. Should the Mattgagor, or his Purchaser, fail to comply with the provisions of the within paragraph, the Mortgage, at its option, may declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable, and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 10. That should the Mortgagor fail to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory rote and the same shall be unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or if there should be any failure to comply with and abide by any by-laws or the charter of the Mortgagor, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the Mortgagor, at its option may write to the Mortgagor at his last known address giving him thirty (30) days in which to rectify the said detailt and should the Mortgagor fail to rectify said default within the said thirty days—the Mortgagor, may, at its option, increase the interest rate on the loan balance for the remaining term of the loan or for a lesser term to the maximum rate per simum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase rate as may be determined by the Association. The monthly payments will be adjusted accordingly.
- 11. That should be Morigagor fail to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory note and should any monthly installment become past due for a period in excess of 15 days, the Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" not to exceed an amount equal to five (5%) per centum of any such past due installment in order to cover the extra expense incident to the handling of such delinquent payments.
- 12. That the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgage, its successors and assigns all the rests issues and profits accruing from the mortgaged premises retaining the right to collect the same so long as the debt hereby secured is not in arrears of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, taxes, or fine insurance premiums, be past due and impaid, the Mortgagee may without notice or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they shall be occupied by a ternat or ternates and collect said rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtedness hereby secured, without lidelity to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of collection, and any tenant is authorized, upon request by Mortgagee, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgagee, without liability to the Mortgager mitil notified to the contrary by the Mortgagee; and should said premises at the time of such default be occupied by the Mortgager, the Mortgagee may apply to the Judge of the County County or to any Judge of the Count of Common Pleas who shall be resident or presiding in the county aforesaid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect such rents and profits, applying said rents, after paying the cost of collection, to the mortgage debt without liability to account for enything more than the rents and profits actually collected.
- 13. That the Modzagee, at its option, may require the Modzager to pay to the Modzagee, on the first day of each month until the note secured hereby is fully paid, the following sums in addition to the payments of principal and interest provided in said note: a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of modzage guaranty insurance (of applicable), fire and other hazard insurance covering the modzaged property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the modzaged premiums (all as estimated by the Modzagee) less all sums already paid therefor, dioded by the number of months to clapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes, and assessments will be due and payable, such sums to be held by Modzagee to pay said premiums, taxes and special assessments. Should these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Modzagee for taxes, assessments as insurance premiums, the excess may be credited by the Modzagee on subsequent payments to be nade by the Modzagee for taxes, assessments as it is small be insufficient to make said payments when the same shall become due and payable, the Modzagee shall pay to the Modzagee may, at its option apply for remewal of modzage guaranty or similar insurance of applicable) covering the balance them remaining due on the modzage debt, and the Modzagee may at its option, pay the single promium required for the remaining years of the term of the Modzagee may pay such premium and add the same to the modzage debt in which even the Modzageer shall repay to Modzagee such premium payment, with interest, at the rife specified in said promissory note, in equal monthly installments over the remaining payment period.

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
