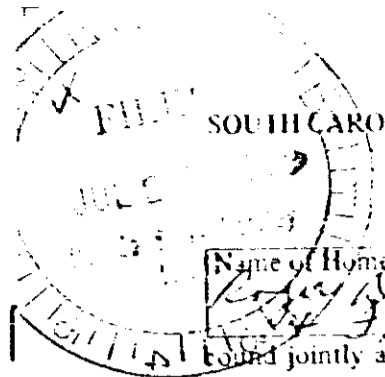

dated August 1 19 32, recorded in the office of the Clerk of Court of Greenville County in Book 1108, Page 439 of which the description in said deed is incorporated by reference.

ALL that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the northern side of Tenth Street, in Section 5 of Judson Mills Village, being known and designated as Lot No. 41 as shown on plat known as "Property of Robert B. and Freida E. Blackstone" as recorded in Plat Book 41 at page 10, in the REC Office for Greenville County, S.C., and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Tenth Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 41 and 42, said pin being 812.8 feet east from the northeastern corner of the intersection of Perkins Avenue and Tenth Street, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 21, N. 1-15 W. 90 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 21, N. 89-09 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 21, N. 1-15 W. 90 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Tenth Street; thence with the northern side of Tenth Street S. 89-09 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD ALL AND SINGULAR unto the said mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns forever. And the mortgagor does hereby bind himself, his heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns from and against himself and his heirs and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. AND the mortgagor covenants with the mortgagee that: The mortgagor will pay the indebtedness as hereinbefore provided; keep the buildings insured against loss or damage by fire for the benefit of the mortgagee in an amount not less than the actual value thereof; observe and perform all covenants, terms and conditions of any prior mortgage; pay all taxes, assessments, water rates, insurance premiums, installments of principal and interest on any prior mortgage, and in any payment the mortgagee may pay the same and the mortgagor shall repay to the mortgagee the amount so paid together with interest at 7% per annum, said amounts to be added to the indebtedness secured by this mortgage; no building shall be removed or demolished without the consent of the mortgagee; the mortgagee shall be entitled to the appointment of a receiver in any action to foreclose; upon default being made upon the payment of any of the installments heretofore specified on the due date hereof, or upon default upon any of the other terms, covenants or conditions of this mortgage or of the note secured hereby, or in the event of sale or transfer of the premises by the mortgagor, then the entire unpaid balance shall immediately become due and payable at the option of the mortgagee, heirs, successors and assigns, and this mortgage may be foreclosed. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the mortgagee become a party of any suit involving this mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and expenses incurred by the mortgagee, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the grantee, as a part of the debt secured hereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder. The mortgagor waives homestead and other exemptions and appraisal rights. The mortgagor hereby authorize(s) the mortgagee/holder to complete and correct the property description and any other terms in accordance with the note which is secured hereby so that this document is a valid and subsisting mortgage and further agrees that the manual transfer of this mortgage to the mortgagee or his agent shall be a valid and adequate delivery of this
