

POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That We, John H. Huellmantel and Barbara L. Huellmantel, of 7313 Angling Road, Kalamazoo, Michigan, do make, constitute and appoint Alan B. And we hereby declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by our said attorney shall be binding on us and our heirs, legal and personal representatives, and assigns whether the same shall have been done before or after our death, or other revocation of this instrument, unless and until reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been received by our said attorney.

This appointment being executed by us shall cover our jointly and severally owned property.

This power of attorney shall expire and terminate on April 30, 1981.
