WHEREAS, I, Willard M. Free

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, in the Town of Greer, lying on the south side of Arlington Avenue, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the sidewalk adjacent to W. Arlington Avenue and running S. 79-03 E. 77 feet to a point marked by an "X" on the concrete; thence S. 17-12 W. 55 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 73-15 W. 4.28 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 16-21 W. 22.05 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 74-00 W. 77.5 feet to an old iron pin; thence N. 21-11 E. 70.46 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is subject to all restrictions, easements, rights of way, roadways and zoning ordinances of record, on the recorded plats or on the premises.
