

(b) The County may, by notice in writing to the Company, declare the entire unpaid balance of either or both of the Company Notes to be immediately due and payable and thereupon the entire unpaid balance, together with all accrued interest thereon, of such Company Note(s) shall be and become immediately due and payable; and

(c) The County personally or by agents or attorneys, shall have the right (subject to compliance with any mandatory legal requirements) to take immediate possession of the Premises or any portion thereof, and for that purpose may pursue the same wherever they may be found, and may enter any of the premises of the Company and search for, take possession of, remove, keep and store the Premises, or use and operate or lease the Premises (and keep the rents and profits thereof) until sold; and

(d) The County may (subject to compliance with any mandatory legal requirements) sell and dispose of said Premises, or any part thereof, at public or private sale, in one lot as an entirety or in separate lots, and either for cash or on credit and on such terms as the County may determine, and at any place (whether or not it be the location of the Premises or any part thereof), and to whomsoever (including the County, First National or Trust Company); provided, however, that any such sale shall be held in a commercially reasonable manner and otherwise in accordance with applicable law; and
