TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, O. MARVIN GLENN

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto the GREENVILLE COUNTY REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of ***Five thousand five hundred seventy-six and no/100***

Dollars (\$5,576.00) due and payable

in 120 consecutive monthly installments of Fifty-nine and 16/100 (\$59.16) Dollars each, due and payable on the fifteenth day of each month, commencing April 15, 1982,

with interest thereon from said date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, to be paid: monthly.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of GREENVILLE, in the Dunean Mills Village, and being more fully described as Lot 23, Section 3, as shown on a plat entitled Subdivision of Dunean Mills, made by Pickell & Pickell Engineers on June 7, 1948; revised June 15, 1948 and August 7, 1948 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book "S" at Pages 173 to 177. Said lot is also known as 17 Duke Street, and fronts thereon 80 feet.

DERIVATION: This being the same property conveyed to the Mortgagor herein by virtue of a deed from Jack C. Meadows and Eugenia Meadows recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 456 at Page 75 on May 12, 1952.
