To Secure to Lender (a) the repayment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon, the payment of all other sums, with interest thereon, advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements of Borrower herein contained, and (b) the repayment of any future advances, with interest thereon, made to Borrower by Lender pursuant to paragraph 21 hereof (herein "Future Advances"), Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender and Lender's successors and assigns the following described property located in the County of ... ALL that piece, parcel, or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the southern side of Riggs Street shown as Lot No. 17 on a plat of Staunton Court dated June, 1966, by Piedmont Engineers Architects, recorded in Plat Book PPP at Page 41A on October 7, 1966, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Riggs Street and running with the common line of Lots 17 and 18 S. 40-58 E. 94.45 feet to a point; thence running S. 47-13 W. 150 feet to a point; thence running with the common line of Lots 17 and 16 N. 40-30 W. 125 feet to a point on the southern side of Riggs Street; thence with the side of the street as follows; N. 53-50 E. 55 feet, S. 89-13 E. 40 feet, W.47-45 E. 35 feet to the point of beginning.
