

Also that portion of land being 0.150 acres of land on the right of Road S-326 between stations 17+05 and 21+28.59.

Also within 75 feet of the centerline of Line E between Survey Stations 265+22 and 268+11.

Also land for a 25'x25' triangle area, on the right, at the intersection of S. C. Rte. 146 and Line E opposite Station 162+70 of the Rte. 146 survey.

Also a 60 foot radius at the intersection of Rte. 146 and Road S-326.

Also all that parcel or strip of land being the entire area Southeast of the new right of way line of Rte. 146 and Road S-326 that extends to the present right of way between approximately Rte. 146 Survey Station 165+25 and Road S-326 Survey Station 11+08 as shown on Plat Sheet 19 of plans for this project.

This being a portion heretofore conveyed to Fiber Industries, Inc., by deed of Nylon Industries, Inc., recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 780 at page 81; and being the identical property conveyed by Fiber Industries, Inc., to the South Carolina Department of Highways and Public Transportation by deed dated May 27, 1982, and to be delivered contemporaneously herewith.

Except for the within described property hereby released and any other property which may have been previously released in accordance with the provisions of the Indenture, the lien of the Indenture shall remain in full force and effect with respect to all other property described therein or covered thereby.
