NOTICE

I beg to call your attention to the fact that the law relative to the duties of Executors, Administrators, Guardians and Committees requires you to render to the Judge of Probate a just and true account, upon oath the receipts and expenditures of such estate. Executors or administrators shall on the first day after expiration of 5 months from the date of appointment and on the first day after the expiration of every 6 months thereafter, render such accounting. The first return shall include a verified itemized statement of all liabilities of such estate, which shall be passed upon. Your failure to do so subjects you to citation, loss of commissions, and possible damage suit by any person interested in such estate. Guardians or committees shall render such accounting annually.

Section 21-15-630, 21-15-1410, 21-15-1430 and 21-13-390 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, outline the above duties fully.
