An undivided one-half interest in and to all that lot of land situate on the northern side of Woodridge Circle, near the Town of Mauldin, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 35 on plat of Windsor Park made by R.K. BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Woodridge Circle, at joint front corner of Lots 34 and 35, and runs thence along the line of Lot 34, N. 29-18 E. 216.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N 76-30 W. 144.4 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 36 S. 13-30 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Woodridge Circle; thence along Woodridge Circle S. 76-30 E. 35.2 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the curve of Woodridge Circle (the chord being S. 68-47 E. 64.8 feet) to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed to the grantee herein subject to the restrictions applicable to Windsor Park recorded in Deed Book 647 at Page 237.
