MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE is made this 28th day of January, 1983, between the Mortgagor, Robert T. Paris and Frances G. Paris, (herein "Borrower"), and the Mortgagee, First Federal Savings and Loan Association of South Carolina, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, whose address is 301 College Street, Greenville, South Carolina (herein "Lender").

WHEREAS, Borrower is indebted to Lender in the principal sum of Ten thousand and No Cents (\$10,000.00) Dollars, which indebtedness is evidenced by Borrower's note dated 01-28-83, (herein "Note"), providing for monthly installments of principal and interest, with the balance of the indebtedness, if not sooner paid, due and payable on Feb 1, 1988

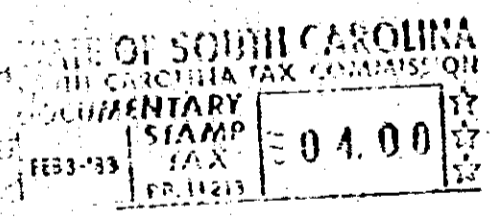
TO SECURE to Lender (a) the repayment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon, the payment of all other sums, with interest thereon, advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements of Borrower herein contained, and (b) the repayment of any future advances, with interest thereon, made to Borrower by Lender pursuant to paragraph 21 hereof (herein "Future Advances"), Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender and Lender's successors and assigns the following described property located in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 128 on a Plat of Pine Brook Forest recorded in Plat Book 4X, at Pages 48 and 49, R.M.C. Office, Greenville County, South Carolina, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 144 and 128 and running thence with Cannon Circle N. 85-20 E. 120 feet to a point; thence running S. 43-20 E. 35 feet to a point on Green Road; thence continuing S. 01-40 W. 130 feet to a point; thence running S. 88-25 W. 138 feet to a point; thence running N. 00-50 W. 150 feet to the point of beginning.

This being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor(s) herein by deed of Roger Bryon Nunn and Linda M. Nunn, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, on 08-10-81, in Deed Book 1153, and Page 272.

This is a second mortgage and is junior in lien to that mortgage executed by Robert T. Paris and Frances G. Paris, in favor of First Federal of South Carolina, which mortgage is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Book 1549, and page 421.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto Lender and Lender's successors and assigns, forever, together with all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, rights, appurtenances, rents, royalties, mineral, oil and gas rights and profits, water, water rights, and water stock, and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to the property, all of which, including replacements and additions thereto, shall be deemed to be and remain a part of the property covered by this Mortgage; and all of the foregoing, together with said property (or the leasehold estate if this Mortgage is on a leasehold) are herein referred to as the "Property."

Borrower covenants that Borrower is lawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property, that the Property is unencumbered, and that Borrower will warrant and defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any declarations, easements or restrictions listed in a schedule of exceptions to coverage in any title insurance policy insuring Lender's interest in the Property.
