C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to us the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S.
