THIS MORTGAGE is made this 14th day of October 1983, between the Mortgagor, Jane H. Greer (herein "Borrower"), and the Mortgagee, AMERICAN FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, whose address is 101 EAST WASHINGTON STREET, GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (herein "Lender").

WHEREAS, Borrower is indebted to Lender in the principal sum of Fourteen thousand and 00/100 Dollars, which indebtedness is evidenced by Borrower's note dated October 14, 1983 (herein "Note"), providing for monthly installments of principal and interest, with the balance of the indebtedness, if not sooner paid, due and payable on April 11, 1984

To SECURE to Lender (a) the repayment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon, the payment of all other sums, with interest thereon, advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements of Borrower herein contained, and (b) the repayment of any future advances, with interest thereon, made to Borrower by Lender pursuant to paragraph 21 hereof (herein "Future Advances"), Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender and Lender's successors and assigns the following described property located in the County of State of South Carolina:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or unit, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Unit No. 210 of Ingleside Horizontal Property Regime as is more fully described in Declaration (Master Deed) dated February 26, 1980 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Deed Book 1121, at Pages 262 through 327, inclusive, and survey and plot plan recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 7-0, at Page 88.

THIS is the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of Ingleside, Inc. recorded May 8, 1980 in Deed Book 1125, Page 445.

Borrower covenants that Borrower is lawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property, that the Property is unencumbered, and that Borrower will warrant and defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any declarations, easements or restrictions listed in a schedule of exceptions to coverage in any title insurance policy insuring Lender's interest in the Property.
