PARCEL NO. 1 - ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, lying and being on the southeasterly side of West Shallowstone Road, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, and being designated as Lot No. 618 on Map One, Section Three, Sugar Creek, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book 9-F, at Page 35, reference to said plat being made for the metes and bounds thereof.

PARCEL NO. 2 - ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, lying and being on the northerly side of East Shallowstone Road, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, and being designated as Lot No. 633 on Map One, Section Three, Sugar Creek, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book 9-F, at Page 35, reference to said plat being made for the metes and bounds thereof.

PARCEL NO. 3 - ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, lying and being at the westerly intersection of North Wingfield Road and East Shallowstone Road, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, and being designated as Lot No. 640 on Map Two, Section Three, Sugar Creek, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book 9-W, at Page 63, reference to which is hereby craved for the metes and bounds thereof.
