

SCHEDULE A

All that certain tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near Pleasant Hill Baptist Church, at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Glassy Mountain Road and Pleasant Hill Road (S.C. Highway #S 23-114), being known and designated as Tract #5 (containing 5 acres) on a plat of property prepared for the Edgar Mitchell Estate by W.N. Willis, Surveyor, dated March 9, 1974, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in center of Glassy Mountain Road at intersection of Pleasant Hill Road and running thence with center of Glassy Mountain Road N. 29-34 W. 100 feet to a bend; thence N. 34-03 W. 375 feet to a point in center of said road corner of Jerry Henson property; thence with the line of Henson N. 80-08 E. 30 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the same course for a total distance of 675 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 18-00 W. 605 feet to a point in center of Pleasant Hill Road, iron pin back on corner at 16 feet; thence with the center of Pleasant Hill Road N. 75-30 W. 225 feet to the line of beginning.
