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MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE is made this 20th day of March, 1984, between the Mortgagor, Michael W. Southerland and June Karen C. Southerland, (herein "Borrower"), and the Mortgagee, First Federal Savings and Loan Association, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, whose address is 301 College Street, Greenville, South Carolina (herein "Lender").

WHEREAS, Borrower is indebted to Lender in the principal sum of Twenty Five Thousand Eighty Nine and 04/100 Dollars, which indebtedness is evidenced by Borrower's note dated March 20, 1984, (herein "Note"), providing for monthly installments of principal and interest, with the balance of the indebtedness, if not sooner paid, due and payable on March 30, 1994.....;

TO SECURE to Lender (a) the repayment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon, the payment of all other sums, with interest thereon, advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements of Borrower herein contained, and (b) the repayment of any future advances, with interest thereon, made to Borrower by Lender pursuant to paragraph 21 hereof (herein "Future Advances"), Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender and Lender's successors and assigns the following described property located in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 20 of a subdivision known as Pebble Creek, Phase II, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book 7-C at Page 50, and having such metes and bounds as shown thereon.

This being the same property conveyed to the Mortgagors herein by deed of Pebblepart, Ltd., a South Carolina General Partnership, recorded October 31, 1979, in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 1114 at Page 654.

This is a second mortgage and is junior in lien to that mortgage given by Michael W. Southerland and June Karen C. Southerland to First Federal Savings and Loan Association dated October 30, 1979, recorded October 31, 1979 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Mortgage Book 1486 at Page 554.
