PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE LIEN

Parcel 1

All that certain piece, parcel or plot of land located in Greenville County, South Carolina, described on that certain Survey and Plat by Terry T. Dill entitled "Plat of Property of Showing Location of Buildings Meta S. Dill, West Greenville, S.C." [sic] which was filed September 28, 1973, in Deed Book 47 at page 82, Office of the Recorder of Mesne Conveyances, Greenville County, conveyed to Herman F. Dill, Jr., by deed from Meta S. Dill dated April 4, 1971, of record in said office in Deed Book 1060, page 539, and also an adjacent tract utilized for parking described in the deed to Herman Franklin Dill, Jr., dated July 26, 1976, of record in said office in Deed Book 1040, page 308.

All that certain piece, parcel or plot of land located in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 1.11 acres more or less, conveyed to Herman Franklin Dill, Jr., by deed from Ellen Towns Taylor dated July 26, 1976, of record in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County July 28, 1976, in Deed Volume 1040, page 308, described as follows:

Beginning in the center of Pendleton Road, Farmer Oil Mill Corner, running thence with said road S. 67 E. 102 feet; thence S. 81.55 E. 331.9 feet; thence continuing with said road S. 83.40 E. 357.3 feet to a railroad spike in road; thence S. 88.50 W. 849 feet along Southern Railroad right-of-way to corner of Farmers Oil Mill and railroad right-of-way; thence N. 26.40 E. with Farmers Oil Mill Line 159.5 feet to the beginning corner, being that triangle formerly owned by Louise Earle and India Earle between Pendleton Road and Southern Railroad, being North of Southern Railway and South of Pendleton Road, same conveyed to Citizens Lumber Co. by J. Robt. Martin, deed recorded Book 152, page 144, R.M.C.O. Greenville County. Less however the following two tracts, pieces or parcels of land:
